## DECLARATION ISSUED UNDER AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 5 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS, 2000 – 2014

In pursuance of its functions under the Planning & Development Acts 2000 to 2014, Kerry County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of the County of Kerry, has by order dated, 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 authorised the issue of a declaration under the provisions of Section 5 of the Planning & Development Acts, 2000 – 2014 in accordance with plans and particulars submitted on the 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2015.

I hereby certify that, the Planning Authority considers that the proposed works which comprise of the construction of a new 110kV underground cable circuit (UGC) from the existing ESB Networks substation at Ballyvouskill, Co. Cork to a permitted wind farm substation at Grousemount, Co. Kerry does constitute exempted development, having regard to the considerations inserted hereunder.

- (a) The proposed works would constitute works that would come within the scope of Section 2(1) of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2014.
- **(b)** The said works would constitute development that comes within the scope of Section 3(1) of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2014 and
- (c) The said works would come within the scope of exemption provided at Classes 16 and 26 of Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 2013.

Therefore the proposed works would constitute development which is exempted development.
