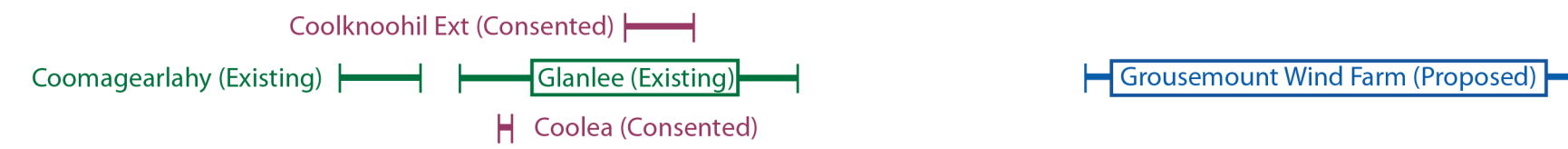
Cumulative Photomontage View



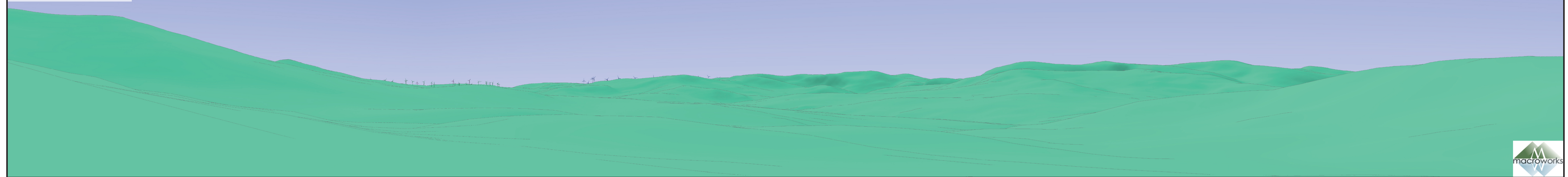
To view this panorama as a flat image one must move from left to right along its length whilst maintaining a perpendicular viewing direction and an approximate **viewing distance of 30cm**. To see this entire panoramic scene in reality would necessitate turning one's head through 60 degrees.
